Over the last few years, your Endowment Fund Board has been working to re-familiarize the congregation with the Endowment Fund and to continue our fiduciary duty to monitor our professional money managers and asset allocation to ensure the Fund's growth and prosperity.

The mission of the Endowment Fund is to:

- Provide a legacy to ensure the future of All Saints Church so that the church's ministries will continue to be strong,
- Provide contingency financial resources for All Saints Church outside of the annual operating budget and for unexpected circumstances, and
- Provide fiscally responsible management of All Saints Church's endowment resources by professional who protect and expand the fund principal.

In recent years Fund grants have been made to the church for the following:

- \$1.2 million grant to the 1996 Building Expansion,
- Repair and replacement of the Bluestone walkways on all sides of the church,
- Upgrade and repairs to the church organ,
- Repairs to the church's roof and gutters,
- Development of the Garden of Remembrance
- Installation of a new HVAC system and a new stove for the Parish hall and kitchen,
- Underground lawn sprinkler system, and
- Playground improvement for All Saints Preschool.

Recap: CARITAS at All Saints

Thank you to all the volunteers who helped make CARITAS week (Jan 2-6, 2012) possible at All Saints!

All Saints hosted 9 homeless families each evening, night, and early morning during the first week of January. There were 25 guests: 9 mothers, 2 fathers and 14 children. The youngest children were ages 5 & 10 months. The oldest were ages 14 & 16 years. The other 10 children ranged in age from 2 to 6 years.

We provided delicious & creative dinners, breakfast each morning, and sandwich lunches to go for the following day. There was continuous Christian fellowship, dinner blessings, welcome kits with pillow prayers, our Healing Service in the Chapel, distribution of socks & warm winter clothing, nightly YMCA showers & a run to the Laundromat (we put our newly refurbished All Saints 1995 Ford Van to the test), games and book readings nightly, movies, and even piano music!

Over 115 volunteers, primarily All Saints parishioners, spent a total 275 hours with our guests. Quality one-on-one time that made our CARITAS outreach program special. Participation was widespread -- All Saints' Kids, Youth, Men's Club, and various All Saints friends, families and circles.

Many of our parishioners participated on multiple nights. Each of us made a difference. We will never fully know how we may have touched the lives of our guests. We do know that our guests loved their visit to All Saints; and that we are blessed to have this outreach opportunity each year. John Philips
