Palm Sunday: March 29

The drama of Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday on March 29. At the 8:00 and 10:30 services we reenact Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem with palms and hosannas. Later we hear again the horrible majesty of Jesus' trial and crucifixion. At 10:30, the choir will be led in procession around the church by bagpipes, and the choir will sing. Please meet on the patio for the 10:30am procession.

Maundy Thursday Service + Dinner: April 2 at 6:00pm

Focusing on Jesus' command to his disciples to love one another as he has loved them and his institution of the Eucharist to be shared together as a sign of our unity in Christ, this service will feature music, Holy Communion, a simple stripping of the altar, and silent procession out as we move into the solemnity of Good Friday. Following the service, we will gather for dinner in the parish hall.
